



To enhance navigation and get the most out of the site. This help page can be printed out and used as a cheat-sheet




 Pan/move map north, south, east or west

The Tool Bar

- COMMENT

Click to activate the COMMENT tool. Left click anywhere on the map you'd like to comment on, fill in the form, and save. Once you finish your session, your comment locations will not be visible though they will all be held in the database for review and potential responses
- ZOOM IN

Click to activate the ZOOM IN tool. Cross hairs will appear  Click, hold, and drag the cross hairs to form a window around the area you wish to zoom in on. You can also simply click once anywhere in the map and it will automatically zoom in approximately 10-20%
- ZOOM OUT


Click to activate the ZOOM OUT tool. Cross hairs will appear. Click, hold, and drag the cross hairs to form a window around the area you wish to zoom out on. The smaller the window/box you create, the more it will zoom out. You can also simply click once anywhere in the map and it will automatically zoom out approximately 10-20%
- PAN

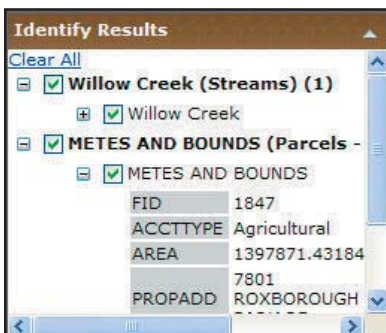
Click to activate the PAN tool 
Click, hold, and drag cursor to push or pull image in any direction.
- AERIAL IMAGE

Click to turn on,
click again to turn off
- ZOOM TO REGION

Click to automatically zoom to the general region
- ZOOM TO PROJECT

Click to automatically zoom to the project area
- ID FEATURE

Click to activate the ID FEATURE tool  In the map, click on any item (parcel, street, stream, etc.) The spatial items that reside in that geography will highlight---there may be more than one item highlighted. For instance, the stream you are looking for information on will highlight as well as the parcel the stream runs through at that point. More information about this item(s) will appear in the "Identify Results" window in the lower left corner of the page.



Information about identified features (parcel, street, stream, etc.) will appear in the Identified Results window in the bottom left corner of the page. Rolling over individual items in this window will highlight the item it refers to in the map.

Expand the feature (click the "+") to get more information about what you have selected.

To Clear:
 Right click on single feature and click "remove"
 Click "clear all" to remove ALL selections
